

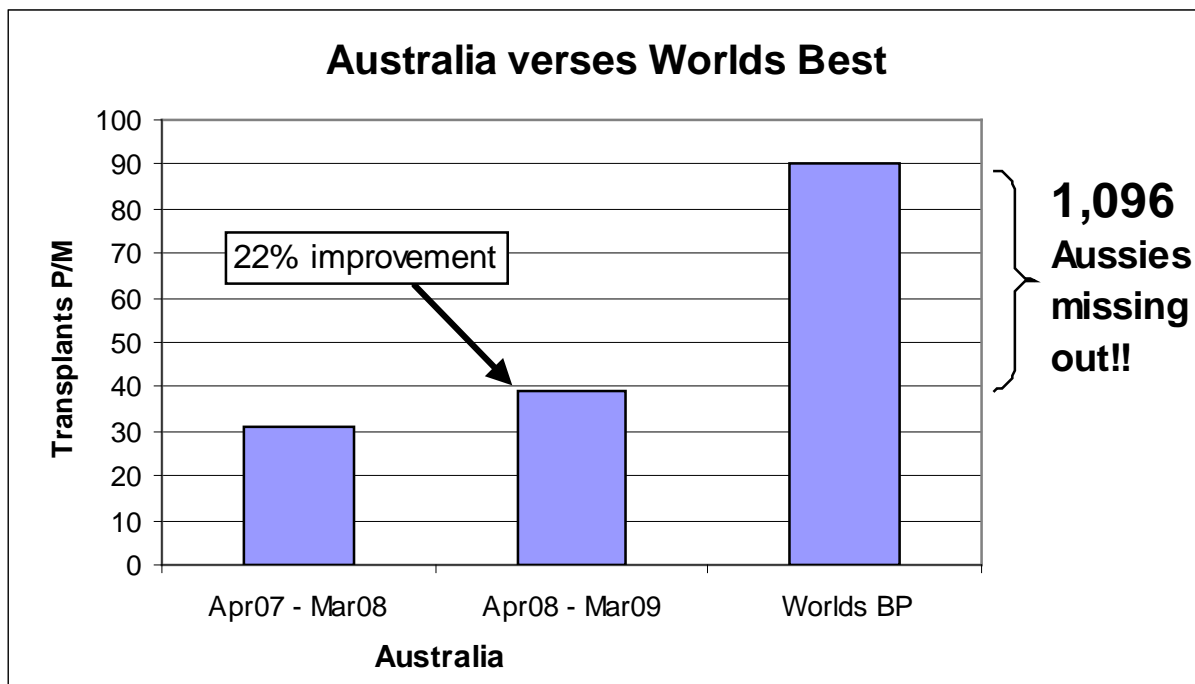
Australia vs World's Best Transplant Recipient Scorecard No.1

March 2009 Update

Encouraging trend in transplant recipients, but a long way to go to equal World's Best Practice with over 1,000 Australians continuing to suffer or die needlessly.

Australia's target is World's Best of at least 90 transplant recipients per million of population



While current trends indicate an improvement in the number of transplant recipients over the previous year, when measured against those countries achieving World Best Practice, a further 1,096 Australians could have benefited from a life transforming transplant. The sad fact is that if this figure was achieved, the number would still be considerably less than those that could benefit from a transplant if even more donated organs were available.
